Guide to Recycling Construction and Demolition Debris

REQUIREMENTS

California law requires cities to continuously reduce the amount of trash delivered to area landfills. The City of Rancho Mirage ("City") has an aggressive recycling program to help meet the State mandate. Recycling construction and demolition debris is an important component of that program.

When you recycle debris from construction and demolition sites, you greatly reduce the impact on our landfills. You also reduce your costs, as recycling facilities usually charge less per ton versus local landfills and transfer stations.

To assist you in finding/utilizing recycling facilities for your construction and demolition debris, the City maintains a list of State approved recycling locations. The list, which may also be found on the City's website, does not necessarily constitute an endorsement by the City. You should exercise due diligence in selecting a recycling facility that meets your needs and complies with City and State law.

Acceptable Materials for Recycling

What constitutes recyclable construction and demolition debris? Any and all of the following:

- Appliances (e.g. stoves, refrigerators, and sinks, bathtubs and toilets)
- Cardboard/paper products
- Drywall/plaster (e.g. drywall, gypsum, sheetrock)
- Greenwaste/woodwaste (e.g. dimensional lumber, clean wood, fence boards, wood waste, pallets, tree trimmings)
- Metals
 - Ferrous (e.g. steel; stainless steel products such as piping; roof flashing)
 - Non-Ferrous (e.g. aluminum, copper, brass)
- Paving materials (e.g. asphalt, bricks, cinder blocks, concrete, dirt)
- Roofing materials

Please refer to the following pages for a list of recycling facilities. Hours, acceptable materials, etc. change over time so use your due diligence in selecting a facility and call first to confirm operating hours, etc.
