Electronic Pesticide Use Reporting using CalAgPermits



You can now submit your Pesticide Use Reports electronically in Sacramento County using the CalAgPermit program, a web based program being used by all counties in California. We are highly encouraging industry to sign up for electronic submittal of use reports as a cost savings measure and to improve efficiency.

 - ✓ If you work in multiple counties, you will need an account in each county.
 - \checkmark If you work in multiple counties, we suggest using the same User Name and add the county name to the end of it. For example: **blueskypestcontrolSAC**, & blueskypestcontrolPLACER.

You will receive an email with a link to your account and a temporary password. Simply log on to your account, change your temporary password and you can begin submitting your use reports electronically.

Note: if you are a structural pest control company, there is a field on the electronic use report to enter the number on the structural sticker. Affix the original structural sticker to a copy of the pesticide use report and keep with your records for 2 years.

If you currently use a software program for your use reports, you can export the information as an xml file directly to CalAgPermits. You will simply need to sign up for a CalAgPermits account.
