Domestic Violence, Sexual Assault, Dating Violence, Stalking, and Human Trafficking Certification

Purpose of Form:

Victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, dating violence, stalking, and human trafficking are eligible for EHVs.

The following individual is applying for a HUD Emergency Housing Voucher (EHV) from the Public Housing Agency listed below, which is currently receiving referrals for victims who are applying for EHV assistance from the following Provider.

Confidentiality:

All information provided to the victim service provider concerning the incident(s) of domestic violence, sexual assault, dating violence, stalking, or human trafficking shall be kept confidential and such details shall not be entered into any shared database. Employees of the Public Housing Agency will not have access to these details, and such employees may not disclose this information to any other entity or individual, except to the extent that disclosure is:

- i. consented to by the victim in writing in a time-limited release;
- ii. required for use in an eviction proceeding or hearing regarding termination of assistance; or
- iii. otherwise required by applicable law.

Note: In order for someone to qualify as an individual or household fleeing or attempting to flee domestic violence, sexual assault, dating violence, stalking, or human trafficking, an arrest or conviction of the perpetrator is NOT required. Additionally, the individual cannot be required to obtain a restraining/protective order or police report, or cannot be required to engage law enforcement, in order to qualify for an EHV.

This is to certify that the information provided on this form is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and recollection, and that the individual(s) named above is/has been a victim of domestic violence, sexual assault, dating violence, stalking, or human trafficking. I acknowledge that submission of false information could jeopardize program eligibility and could be the basis for denial of admission, termination of assistance, or eviction.
