



PRIVACY PROTECTION REQUIREMENTS

The purpose of these privacy protection measures is to mitigate privacy impacts and the visual mass and bulk of new two-story homes and additions. See **CMC Section 19.28.120** for privacy planting requirements and *Privacy Trees and Shrubs* handout for allowed plant species and maximum spacing requirements.

Plans must note prescribed thirty-degree angle from proposed second-story windows and balconies to demonstrate proper plant screening.

Submittal Requirements:

- ☐ A planting plan that identifies the location, species, and canopy diameter of existing and proposed trees or shrubs pursuant to the requirements in CMC Section 19.28.120 (C).
 - □ *Release of Privacy Protection Measures* form, if applicable.

Prior to Final Building Inspection:

- □ Submit the *Privacy Protection Planting Affidavit* signed by a **Certified Arborist** or a **Licensed Landscape Architect**.
- □ Reduced 11"x17" copy of approved planting plan.
- A covenant recorded with the Santa Clara County Recorder's Office requiring property owner maintenance of protected privacy trees.
- Schedule a Planning Inspection for privacy planting. Please note that trees and shrubs must be planted prior to issuance of a final occupancy permit.
