

FLAGGING REQUEST FORM

INSTRUCTIONS

Date Submitting to CARB: Date the Flagging Request Form is being submitted to CARB.

Submitting District: Name of District (APCD or AQMD) requesting flag.

Monitoring Site: Name of Monitoring Site.

AQS Number: AQS ID (06-xxx-xxxx).

POC: AQS POC.

Pollutant Type: PM2.5/PM10/Ozone.

Pollutant Code: e.g., 88101. Only regulatory data (e.g., 81102, 88101, 44201).

Date: Date of Event. If event spans more than one day, list each day separately.

Concentration: Daily or Hourly Average.

Units: ug/m3 or ppm.

Averaging Time: Daily or Hourly.

Start Time: 1st hour of impact (00 for PM2.5 and PM10).

End Time: Last hour of impact (23 for PM2.5 and PM10).

Current Flag: If data is already flagged (e.g., with an 'IT').

Requested Flag: select from the list below. EPA requests that initial flagging uses INFORM Flags; if full documentation will be necessary, data will be reflagged with REQUEST Flags.
