ELECTION DAY REMINDER 2020 GENERAL ELECTION

LOS ANGELES (November 3, 2020) — Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott reminds voters that today, November 3, 2020 is General Election Day. LA County voters can vote at any Vote Center in the County. Although all registered voters in California received a Vote by Mail Ballot for the General Election, safe in-person voting is available. State and County public health and safety guidelines will be strictly followed. Voters will be required to wear masks and adhere to social distancing guidelines and other measures.

CONDITIONAL VOTER REGISTRATION:

Eligible Los Angeles County residents who missed the October 19 registration deadline can still vote at any Vote Center in L.A. County. Under California Election Law, Conditional Voter Registration (CVR) allows a prospective voter to conditionally register and cast a ballot. HOW AND WHERE TO VOTE:

For General Election Day, voters will have three options to cast their ballots.

- **At a Vote Center:** Voters can cast or drop-off their voted ballot at any Vote Center throughout the County. Voters received three mailers, their Sample Ballot, a booklet of all Vote Center locations, and a postcard identifying the three closest Vote Center locations and Official Ballot Drop Boxes. Voter Centers are open from 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. To find a Vote Center location and see their estimated wait times visit <https://locator.lavote.net/>.
- **At an Official Ballot Drop Box:** Voters can securely drop off their voted ballot at any of the over 400 Drop Box locations throughout the County on Election Day. Please note Ballot Drop Boxes will be closed at 8:00 p.m. Find the nearest locations at <https://locator.lavote.net/vbm/>.
- **By Mail:** Voters can mail in their ballot today, Election Day. Ballots must be postmarked today, November 3, and received within 17 days, to be accepted.
