THE WESTLAKE VILLAGE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION is dedicated to promote and provide charitable, cultural and educational activities, programs and services for the benefit of those who live in the City of Westlake Village. We are a California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation.

In 2015, the Foundation is offering up to two (2) \$1,000 scholarships to graduating senior students of Agoura High School, who have had significant involvement in either the Music program or the Performing Arts program at Agoura High School. To be eligible, the student must be a resident of the City of Westlake Village and have plans to attend a four-year university, a community college or arts college in the coming year. The award is to help in covering expenses related to the student's continuing education.

An application form, provided by THE WESTLAKE VILLAGE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION, must be completed and submitted by interested seniors. Members of the Foundation will review these applications and interview applicants prior to final selection.

The scholarships will be awarded based on commitment to and demonstrated excellence in programs at Agoura High School in either Music or Performing Arts. Criteria will include years of involvement and level of accomplishment as perceived by members of the staff and faculty of Agoura High School. Other factors will include: academic achievement, school service, community service, interview and financial need.
