- Step 1 Fill out Fire Code Permit Application.
 - 1a) Applicant's name is the person or firm which will be responsible for equipment, storage, etc., after the permit is issued.
 - 1b) Mailing address of the person or firm requesting the permit.
 - 1c) Job address (location) of the premises where the permit will be posted.
 - 1d) If the installer or contractor or equipment, etc., applies for the permit for a person or firm, the installer or contractor signs the space provided.
 - 1e) Fill out the portion that describes the type of permit you are requesting, i.e., tent or canopy; operate a vehicle spray paint booth; open flame, etc.
 - 1f) Applicant's signature.
- Step 2 Mail or fax in the completed application.
- Step 3 The Fire Prevention Bureau will review the permit application and will determine the code requirements you must comply with for your request. In the event additional information is required (such as a plot plan or information on materials or .
- Step 4 You will be notified by the Fire Prevention Bureau that your application has been approved/denied and shall receive your permit at this time.
- Step 5 The completed permit is to be posted at your premises for review by the fire department during their inspection or when requested by a member of the fire department.
