

#### (Combination Smoke/Carbon Monoxide detectors are recommended)

### **Placement Considerations:**

- Remember that every level, including basements also require both carbon monoxide and smoke detectors.
- Smoke detectors shall have a minimum <u>10-vear</u> rated battery (*effective July 1, 2014*).
- Detectors shall be located a minimum of <u>twenty (20) feet away</u> from cooking appliances.
- Detectors shall be located **three (3) feet away** from openings into bathrooms, mechanical supply / return registers, and ceiling fans.
