## SPECIAL ANIMAL PERMIT (POULTRY) CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

In accordance with Chapter 6.13, Other Animals, of Title 6, Animals, of the Weed Municipal Code, Special Animal Permits may be issued by the City Manager, or designee, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. No male poultry\* (such as, but not limited to, rooster, drake, gander, etc.) beyond the age of three (3) months.
- 2. No more than eight (8) female poultry\* (such as, but not limited to, hen, goose, etc.) dependent on space available. Re-application is required to expand the flock.
- 3. A proper shelter shall be provided for the animals and the shelter must meet any applicable City building codes.
- 4. A proper fence shall be erected around the animal shelter to keep the animals from wandering off the property and to keep predator animals out.
- 5. The Weed Police Department shall have the opportunity to perform periodic inspections to determine cleanliness and welfare of the animals.
- 6. Waste, noise, and odor shall be controlled.
