## **NOTICE TO PARTICIPANTS**

Pursuant to City of Los Angeles Ordinance No. 187219, beginning Monday, November 29, 2021, proof of vaccination will be required for individuals eligible for COVID vaccination to enter all Public buildings including all Recreation and Parks' facilities. For those unable to provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination alternative programming is available. Visit <u>https://bit.ly/rapalt</u> for more information.

The City will be **enforcing** the indoor vaccine mandate (City Ordinance #187219) starting **Monday**, **November 29**, **2021**, as follows:

- All individuals **12 years and older** must be fully vaccinated by November 29th to continue participating in indoor programming at recreational facilities, and/or to enter Recreation and Parks' facilities.
- All individuals **5 to 11 years and younger** must provide a weekly negative COVID test result for all *moderate and high risk indoor activities*. **EXEMPTION**: Those that are fully vaccinated.

Medical and/or religious exemptions will not be made at this time in connection with the City's ordinance for access to City facilities, as it is beyond our abilities to track and verify medical and religious exemptions for the public, and then further check and authorize testing and proof of negative COVID tests.

Face masks are still required.

## What happens after November 29th for those 12 years and up?

After this date, those 12 years and up that are NOT fully vaccinated will **not** be eligible to participate in indoor programming. However, once they **are** fully vaccinated, they may participate.

\***Fully vaccinated is defined as:** two weeks or more after receiving a second dose of the Pfizer or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine, or two weeks or more after receiving the single dose of the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine.

Vaccine Verification (one of the following):

- Vaccination card with person's name, type of vaccine, and date the last dose was administered (must be at least two weeks after the last dose), OR
- A photo of a vaccination card (both sides) with same info as above on it, OR
- Documentation of vaccination from a licensed healthcare provider, OR
- An electronic vaccination card.

AND, if 18 years or older:

- Driver's license, OR
- Government issued I.D. card, OR
- School or work I.D., OR
- Passport.

Those under 18 years of age are not required to provide a photo I.D.
