PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED ALLOCATION BY THE ALPINE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR USE OF TITLE III FUNDING PROVIDED UNDER HR-2389

The Alpine County Board of Supervisors is proposing to allocate funds in the following amounts under the Reauthorization of the Secure Rural Schools and Community Self Determination Act: Alpine Fire Safe Council in the amount of \$3,354; Bear Valley Chipping Project in the amount of \$10,000; and Alpine County Community Development in the amount of \$10,062. The 45-day comment period is open through August 20, 2021. The final plans will be considered and adopted by the Board of Supervisors after the 45-day comment period. This notice is provided according to Section 302 of PL 110-343.
