What is a Mobile Vendor Permit? A Mobile Vendor Permit allows the vending of produce, prepared or prepackeaged foods, goods, wares, and/or serivces at semi-permanent locations on private property. Mobile vendors may vend from a single or several locations on a regular basis.

The City recognizes the community benefits that occur from outdoor concessions but the activity may pose unsafe conditions and special dangers to the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City, therefore the City regulates vending activity. Vending activity is subject to a revocable permit and compliance with performance standards and conditions as described in Chapter 9.32 of the Arroyo Grande Municipal Code.
