Upon review of this permit application, the applicant will be notified in writing of the proposal's consistency or inconsistency with the provisions of Chapter 9.24 of the Del Mar Municipal Code. If the project is found to be consistent with the provisions of Chapter 9.24, an unsigned permit will be issued and sent to the applicant listed herein. If approved, the permit will have conditions attached.

The permit will not become effective until it is signed by the applicant and returned to the City along with any information or documentation required by the conditions of the permit. At such time, the permit will be signed by the City and returned to the applicant.

One of the conditions of the Permit will require the applicant to submit proof of liability insurance in the amount of \$100,000 which names the City of Del Mar as an additional insured. Another condition will require the applicant to indemnify the City and hold the City and its agents and officers harmless against liability occurring from the installation or maintenance of the news rack. The indemnification language will be included as one of the conditions of approval on the permit to be provided by the City.

Again, the permit will not become valid until it is signed and returned to the City along with any information/documentation required by the conditions of the permit, at which time the Permit will be signed by a City representative and returned to the applicant.

If the permit application is found to be inconsistent with the provisions of Chapter 9.24, the applicant will be notified of the specific inconsistencies and the manner in which the proposal may be modified to bring it into compliance with the Municipal Code so that a valid permit may be issued.
