- 8. The defendant must work at a lawful occupation unless excused by the probation officer for schooling, training, or other acceptable reasons and must notify the probation officer at least ten days before any change in employment or within 72 hours of an unanticipated change.

As such, I declare the following information is accurate and I will update the Probation Office if anything changes, as ordered by the Court. I understand that failing to report changes may result in the Probation Office seeking Court intervention, which may include requesting a bench warrant, if the Probation Office is unable to locate me.
