*P3a. Description:

This is an example of a Queen Anne Cottage with an elaborate porch and woodwork. The house is L-shape in plan with a slightly raised foundation. The roof is a gable-on-hip with a projecting cross gable that extends over a canted bay. The gables are trimmed with a decorative fascia and are supported on intricately worked brackets. The closed eaves are supported on brackets. Brackets with drop newels also are found at the angles of the canted bay. The gable end is clad with a decoratively laid square shingle. The canted bay on the west side of the front façade has one-over-one windows that have decorative muntins. The casings and sills are elaborated with applied wood cut-work. An irregular porch with a canted angle on the west side, occupies a large portion of the front façade and is the most prominent feature of the house. The porch has a flat roof with a frieze that exhibits a cut-out circular pattern that is unusual. Turned porch posts with brackets support the roof and frieze. The low open rail repeats the circular pattern of the frieze. The entry door is paneled. The porch stair is concrete replacement. The house is clad with clapboard except for the foundation which is covered with vertical boards.

This is an unusually detailed example of a Queen Anne Cottage. Important elements include the roof brackets, the window casing treatment, the partially canted porch, the circular patterned frieze and porch rail. These details give the house a striking appearance. There have been few alterations to the building. The replacement of the front steps does not affect its overall integrity, which is notable for design, workmanship and materials. The house is shown as contributing to the Downtown District on the 1991 District Conservation Plan map and should continue to contribute to the Downtown Historic District.


