Note: This exemption will not take effect until the application has been verified and approved by the Tax Administrator and processed by the utilities. The City has up to 60 days to process your request for exemption and if approved, notify the utility companies.

The exemption becomes effective on the beginning of the second regular billing period commencing after the utility companies have been notified. Residents may be eligible for a refund of taxes improperly collected by the utilities. Residents seeking a refund must contact the City of Newark Finance Department.

It is a misdemeanor for any person to knowingly receive the benefits of the exemptions when the basis for the exemption does not exist or ceases to exist. It is your responsibility to notify the City, within 10 days, if there is a change in fact or circumstances which might disqualify you from receiving the exemption.

I am aware that if denied, I have the right to file an amended application, or to appeal the Tax Administrator's decision to the City Manager within a ten-day period after the mailing date of the Tax Administrator's notification.

I understand that this exemption must be renewed no later than 2 years from the date of authorization. (It is recommended that you reapply two months prior to minimize any lapse in eligibility.)

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED

- 1. A copy of your most recent utility bills (the first page of the most recent billing for each account).
- 2. A copy of applicant's California ID or Driver's License, or other comparable form of identification.
