CITY COUNCIL TAKES ACTION ON INITIATIVE PETITION REGARDING CITY MOBILITY PLAN STREET IMPROVEMENT MEASURE

LOS ANGELES (August 26, 2022) — Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announced today that on August 24, 2022, City Council took action to submit an initiative petition regarding *City Mobility Plan Street Improvement Measures* to the voters at the City's Primary Nominating Election held on March 5, 2024.

On August 9, 2022, the initiative petition requesting adoption of the proposed ordinance was presented to the City Council. Pursuant to Charter Section 452(b) (3), the City Council has determined to submit the initiative ordinance, without alteration, to a vote of the electors of the City at the March 5, 2024 Primary Nominating Election-to be conducted by the County of Los Angeles.
