EARLY VOTING BEGINS

2022 PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION

LOS ANGELES (May 26, 2022) — Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott reminds eligible voters that the voting period for the June 7, 2022 Primary Nominating Election begins on Saturday, May 28, 2022. In addition to all registered voters in California receiving a Vote-By-Mail (VBM) ballot, safe, in-person voting will be available.

CONDITIONAL VOTER REGISTRATION:

Eligible Los Angeles County residents who missed the May 23, 2022 registration deadline can still vote at any Vote Center in Los Angeles County. Under California Election Law, Conditional Voter Registration (CVR) allows a prospective voter to conditionally register and cast a ballot. HOW AND WHERE TO VOTE:

For the June 7, 2022 Primary Nominating Election, voters will have three options to cast their ballots.

- At a Vote Center: Voters can cast or drop-off their voted ballot at any Vote Center throughout the
 County. Select Vote Centers will be open as early as Saturday, May 28, 2022 and all Vote Centers will
 be open on Saturday, June 4, 2022, through Election Day, Tuesday, June 7, 2022. Voters will receive
 three mailers: their official sample ballot, a booklet of all Vote Center locations, and a postcard
 identifying the three closest Vote Center locations and VBM drop-boxes. Find locations at

- At a Ballot Drop-Box: Voters can also securely drop off their voted ballot at any of the 400 Ballot Drop
 Box locations throughout the County through Election Day. Find the nearest locations at
 https://locator.lavote.gov/locations/vbm
- **By Mail:** Voters can mail their ballot in until Election Day, June 7, 2022 (if postmarked by Election Day and received within seven days, it will be accepted).

The City's Primary Nominating Election will be held June 7, 2022, and the General Municipal Election will be held November 8, 2022.
