FILING PERIODS BEGIN FOR 2022 PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION

CANDIDATE DECLARATION OF INTENTION AND NOMINATING PETITIONS

LOS ANGELES (January 27, 2022) - Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announced today that the candidate filing period for the 2022 City of Los Angeles Primary Nominating Election begins February 7, 2022. Interested candidates must file a Declaration of Intention to Become a Candidate and submit a qualifying nominating petition in order to appear on the June 7, 2022, Primary Nominating Election ballot.

As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, the City Clerk's Office is closed for in-person services. However, candidate and nominating petition filing will be available by appointment. Starting Monday, January 31, 2022, candidates can begin contacting the City Clerk's office at (213) 978-0444 to make appointments to file a Declaration of Intention form, pick up petitions, and file petitions. Appointments will be available on a first-come, first-served basis starting on February 7, 2022 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Candidates can schedule their appointments and obtain additional information by calling the Election Division during regular business hours, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. or by visiting our website and selecting the "Municipal Election" section on the City Clerk's website at: clerk.lacity.org/election.
