City Manager's Office

Meeting with City's Street Sweeper Company

On Wednesday, June 3, 2015, staff met with Nationwide Environmental Services, the City's street sweeper company. In the future months, staff and representatives from Nationwide will analyze the current street sweeping schedule to make sure the City is maximizing its street cleaning service.

Working with Republic Services for a Cleaner City

Staff is currently working with Republic Services, the City's trash company to develop alternatives to trash bins/cans staying out too long on streets, overflowing with trash, and damaged graffiti.



Animal Control Presentation at Council Meeting

The Department of Animal Care and Control of the County of Los Angeles will present a report of their current canvassing efforts at the upcoming regular City Council Meeting on Monday, June 8, 2015. They will indicate the current up to date information regarding how many homes and animals they have come in contact with.

Customer Service Training

Staff attended the second session of three trainings for customer service on Thursday, June 5, 2015. This specialized customer service training is instructed by Global Learning Partners Inc (GLP). The training last session will take place before the end of June 2015. Providing exemplary customer service is a vital part of our day to day operations. These trainings are one of many steps being taken toward improving City services.

New Insurance Program

At the May 19, 2015 City Council Meeting, the Council approved staff's recommendation to change its insurance program from California Joint Powers Insurance Authority (CJPIA) to the Municipal Insurance Purchasing Cooperative Authority (MIC) through Keenan and Associates. The transition is in progress now and the City will be covered by MIC starting July 1, 2015.

City Budget FY 2015-16 Presentation

At the upcoming June 8, 2015 City Council Meeting, the Finance Director will present the City Council and public with an update on the draft City Budget. Please plan on attending. The document will be available the week of June 8, 2015.

Vacant Commission Seats

At the May 5, 2015 City Council meeting, Council gave the City Clerk's Office direction to give notice to all City Commissioners that they would have to reapply to participate in Commissions. The City Clerk's Office will first notice the vacant commission seats (all) and accept applications to present to the City Council at the July 20, 2015 City Council meeting.

Community Development and Services Department

\$1.3 Million Requested through the Active Transportation Program Grant

On Friday, May 28, the City submitted an application to CalTrans in response to the Active Transportation for more than \$1,300,000! If awarded this grant would fund pedestrian safety enhancements along Wilcox Avenue from Patata Street to Live Oak Street. The pedestrian safety enhancements will include pedestrian lighting at crosswalks, raised crosswalks, extended curbs, and flashing beacons at pedestrian crossings. The City will find out in December 2015 if we are awarded the grant.

Clara Expansion Park Grand Opening and Dedication

If you have not already visited the new expansion at Clara Expansion Park, please visit the park and take advantage of the new outdoor exercise equipment or BBQ picnic areas. As of May 1, the park has been open to the public. Please join us on June 26th, 2015 at 9:30 a.m. the City will be hosting a grand opening ceremony and dedication to Senator Ricardo Lara for his dedication and commitment to the City of Cudahy and assistance in preserving the funds to complete the park.

2016 General Plan Update

As discussed in the May 21, 2015 City Managers Report, recommendation for award of a professional services agreement was to be considered at the June 22, 2015 City Council meeting. However, in order to meet with the top scoring proposers, consideration has been postponed to July 20th, when staff will make a recommendation to City Council for award of a professional services agreement.

Food Distribution

On Thursday, May 28, 2015, the City of Cudahy held its monthly Food Distribution at Clara Street Park. A total of 202 families received goods such as apples, beans, rice, and bread. 21 volunteers were present to assist in the distribution of goods. The upcoming Food Distribution is scheduled to take place on Thursday, June 25, 2015 at 8:30 a.m. Please be sure to have valid proof of residency on hand to avoid being turned away at the door.

ENGINEERING

Cudahy Citywide Street Repair and Maintenance Project

On May 5, 2015, The Cudahy City Council awarded a Construction Services Contract to FS Construction for the Cudahy Citywide Street Repair and Maintenance Project. Construction is tentatively scheduled to start June 8th and it is expected that project will be completed by July 2015. During project construction you will find pedestrian detours at several locations citywide. We ask you for your cooperation and understanding in case your sidewalk and/or driveway is being repaired. The Contractor and the City will do every effort to minimize any inconvenience that construction activity may cause.

The project scope of work includes cold milling existing asphalt concrete and asphalt concrete overlay at specific damaged areas (repair of potholes) and crack sealing existing cracks on asphalt concrete. It also entails the removal and replacement of damaged sidewalks, driveways, curb and gutters, and/or cross gutters; cold mill existing sidewalks to eliminate tripping hazard, installation and modification of corner access ramps to meet the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA); as well as the completion of other miscellaneous items, including traffic striping and traffic control.

This project is a citywide project that includes repair and maintenance on all arterials, corridors and local streets within the City's jurisdiction as described in the project scope of work.

City of Cudahy Americans with Disabilities (ADA) Transition Plan

The City of Cudahy is currently preparing an ADA Transition Plan to comply with the requirements set by the Americans with Disabilities Act. The plan will detail and schedule how the City will make its streets and roads accessible to disabled individuals. For this purpose Disability Access Consultants, Inc is currently working on the City of Cudahy ADA Transition Plan. City of Cudahy ADA Transition Plan is expected to be completed by July/August 2015.

On July 26, 1990, the Americans with Disabilities Act was enacted, which provides comprehensive civil rights protections to persons with disabilities in the areas of employment, state and local government services, and access to public accommodations, transportation, and telecommunications. Federal regulations by the Department of Justice require municipalities (cities), to prepare a plan detailing how they will make their streets, roads and other facilities accessible to disabled individuals. This is recognized as the ADA Transition Plan. The main purpose of the ADA Transition Plan is to develop policies and practices for implementing physical pedestrian

improvements within the public right of way. The ADA Transition Plan is expected to be completed by August 2015.

Engineering and Traffic Survey

The City of Cudahy is currently preparing an Engineering and Traffic Survey for various streets within the City of Cudahy. The report is being prepared based on a detailed field investigation, survey of travel speeds and accident history of various roadway segments in the City. For this purpose Willdan Engineering is currently working on the City of Cudahy Engineering and Traffic Survey. As you may noticed, vehicle counters are installed throughout the City to record traffic data which will be used to generate said report. The Engineering and Traffic Survey is expected to be completed by August 2015.
