Winners will be recognized at the City's annual ARD event on Saturday, November 16th at the Air Quality Management District Parking Lot - 21865 Copley Drive.

THEME: "What can I recycle?"

POSTER REQUIREMENTS

- The poster must be done individually by a 5th grade student.
 One entry per student.
- The poster must be related to the contest theme "What can I recycle?".
- The poster must be no larger than 8.5 x 11 inches on white paper. No lined paper.
- No copyrighted material, computer graphics, companies, organizations, or characters. All artwork must be original.
- The poster can be done in any medium (paint, marker, crayon, colored pencil). Bright colors are encouraged!
- All entries must be delivered FLAT, not rolled or folded.
- Entry forms must be included with each entry.

- ✓ Appropriate dimensions
- ✓ Entry form is included
