Public Works Report

February 2021

Water

1. Water consumption for the month was down 2.8% compared to February 2013.
2. Repaired water leak on service line at 507 East Line Street.
3. Performed quarterly water meter readings.
4. Took routine bacteria samples.
5. Sprayed weeds at well #4 and 1 million gallon tank site.
6. Trimmed trees along west fence at well #4 site.
7. Met with Danny Boyd regarding new barbed wire fence along bike path for North Sierra Highway water line project. Fence was also completed on February 18.
8. Released the North Sierra Highway Waterline Project for bidding. Bids close on March 17, 2021.

Sewer

1. Continued effort to reduce any impact of nutrients on groundwater near the wastewater treatment plant.
2. Continued the process of submitting forms to NRCS in hopes of securing funding for the Irrigation Improvement Project proposed by the Bishop Area Wastewater Authority.
3. Continues to work with Los Angeles Water and Power to acquire additional land for the spreading of secondary treated wastewater.
4. Submitted the Title 22 Engineering Report to the California Division of Drinking Water.
5. Performed inspection on new grease interceptor at Jack in the Box.
6. Performed routine cleaning of trouble sewer mains.
7. Replaced sewer lateral at 163 Short Street.

8. Took monthly BOD samples.
9. Replaced concrete surround on sewer manhole in bowling alley parking lot.
10. Cleaned out irrigation ditches at WWTP discharge area.
11. Cleaned probe at Johnston Drive lift station.
12. Repaired aerator #7 at WWTP.
13. Cleaned sand out of vault above headworks at WWTP.

Streets

1. Removed curb between driveways at 206 South Second Street.
2. Swept city streets and alleys.
3. Repaired damaged street signs at various locations around city streets.

Miscellaneous

1. Performed routine maintenance on the Public Works fleet.
2. Built pad with A.C. grindings for shipping containers at fire training facility.
3. Provided weekly Tail Gate Safety meetings for the Public Works crew.
4. Inspected new storm interceptor installation by Clair construction on Home Street.
5. Moved wood Chips and dirt for Dan McElroy at City Park.
6. Participated in meetings with LADWP real estate to discuss land and housing shortage issues in and near the city of Bishop.
